DROP OFF DAYS

November 20, 2024
4pm - 8pm

November 21, 2024
8am - 8pm

- The Gas South Convention Center will open for Drop Off on Wednesday, November 20th (4pm-8pm) & Thursday, November 21st (8am-8pm).
- In order to launch the auction on time, donors must drop off their nativity by 8pm on Thursday, November 21st.
- Keep an accurate record of your expenses for your tax purposes. We do not need copies of your receipts - just the itemized list (see page 6). Please keep receipts for your own records.
- If you need to make adjustments to your nativity on-site, please make sure to bring the necessary supplies including scissors, florist wire, wire cutters, glue gun, pliers, or an extension cord with you to the Gas South Convention Center.
- More specific information about day-of procedures will be emailed weekly starting in October. If you are not receiving regular emails from us, please contact a member of our auction team.
- At check out, upon completion of your wreath, you will receive ten (10) "thank-you" general admission tickets that can be used to attend the Festival any day November 23-December 1, 2024.

NATIVITY CREATION GUIDELINES

Stand Out!

- Be creative – think of ways to make your Nativity stand out.
- The tables are covered with cloth. However, you may provide a separate table covering (we will sell any coverings provided with your item) to compliment your creation.
- If using battery operated lights, please include extra batteries.
- Live plants, water ornaments, snow globes, or other water features are not allowed.
- All creations become the property of the Georgia Festival of Trees upon completion and will be priced and sold as such.



What does it cost to donate a nativity to the festival?

There is no cost to donate a nativity. We encourage donors to creatively decorate their nativities to attract the highest bids, which supports our cause and charity partners.

When are drop off days?

Drop Off Days are on Wednesday, November 20, 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., and Thursday, November 21, 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Where is the festival located?

The festival will be held at the Gas South Convention Center, 6400 Sugarloaf Parkway, Duluth, GA 30097. Directions for decorating day drop-off and other details will be provided to all donors via email.

How are nativity spaces assigned?

Nativity spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, balanced with spatial and design considerations for the festival.

What happens if my nativity does not sell?

Any auction items that are not sold during the event will be donated to local charities or families in need. To date, the Georgia Festival of Trees has never had an auction item remain unsold. We are grateful to all who continue to support this important cause.

I can't make the Drop Off Day hours. Can I bring my nativity another time?

We appreciate you making every effort to join us on our scheduled Drop Off days. If this is not possible, please speak with your assigned auction representative to discuss alternative arrangements.

How do you determine the opening bid?

The opening bid for each item is set by our auction committee, which considers the fair market value, uniqueness, and potential interest from buyers. This decision is based on historical data, current market conditions, and the overall presentation of the auction item.

What does Suggested Retail Value mean?

Suggested Retail Value is the 'sticker price' of your item; the full retail cost of your nativity and all its decorations. This information helps bidders understand the value of your donation. For any items purchased at wholesale, the retail value/ 'sticker price' is generally double the wholesale cost.

Can I donate a gift certificate or other items with my auction item?

Yes, additional donations such as gift certificates or other items are welcome and add value to your auction contribution. Any items included in the centerpiece space will be sold with the auction item.

Be sure to note any gift certificates or extra items on your submission forms and hand them directly to an auction representative at check-out on Drop Off Day.

What cause does the auction support?

Proceeds from the auction go to Street Grace and Atlanta Redemption Ink, local organizations working to eradicate the sexual exploitation of women and children in Georgia and beyond. Funds provided directly impact individuals in our local communities.

If I'm just dropping off a nativity, do I have to pay to park?

No, if we have received all required information for your donation(s) in our system prior to Drop off Day, we will have an express drop-off area for wreaths, centerpieces, and nativity donations - saving time and parking fees.

Please remember that we must have all the required information for your donation in our system before you can drop it off. If this information is missing, you will be asked to park and come inside to provide the missing info. Please contact your auction representative if you have questions about providing your auction item information.

Can my business name be on the nativity?

Please refrain from placing your business name on your nativity or other donation. Your business name can be included on items around your centerpiece and can be placed on your official auction card.

What are some of the benefits of donating a nativity?

- Recognition: Your name and/or business name will be prominently displayed on your auction item.
- Program Acknowledgment: We'll include your name or business in our festival program. (You must provide your complete item information by the deadline to be included in the program.)
- Online Visibility: Receive recognition on our website and social media platforms.
- Complimentary Tickets: Enjoy ten free, general admission tickets to the festival to share with friends, family, or colleagues.

To raise as much as possible for the those women and children touched by Street Grace and Atlanta Redemption Ink, we intend to price all auction items to sell. This form will help the Georgia Festival of Trees Executive Board determine a fair base price for auction items. The Georgia Festival of Trees Executive Board retains the right to adjust any item’s price to what the market will bear. Retain all receipts for YOUR tax purposes.

NOTE: The Georgia Festival of Trees does not collect your receipts.
